The Mount Vernon Eruv Committee is pleased to announce the completion of a two-and-a-half year project, the planning and implementation of a community *eruv*. Funded by the generous contributions of community members and designed and constructed under the supervision of Rabbi Herschel Schachter, the eruv encompasses the northern half of the city and includes all of Mount Vernon's synagogues. In addition to the availability of the other programs, amenities and services of an active Jewish community, Mount Vernon is the home of Westchester County's only supervised kosher restaurant and a nursing home under the auspices of the National Council of Young Israel. With its convenience to Manhattan — a 25 minute ride on Metro North — and its proximity to several major highways, the community combines the benefits of an attractive suburban Jewish life with all the advantages of New York City just minutes away.
