Torah is to a man what Tzniut is to a woman

**Kiddushin 30: “I created the Yetzer ha Ra
and I created the Torah to manage it
(Transform it to be used for good)”**

**The way for a woman to combat the onslaughts of the Yetzer
ha ra is through behaving with Tzeniut,
with Modesty and privacy**

**Therefore we see that The Vilna Gaon
writes in Iggeret ha Gra to his mother:
My Dear Mother, I know that you don't need my advice
(Mussar), because you are very modest. (tznuva)**

(Based on Rav Segal Shlita, as brought in Modesty, An adornment for life)

**The Maharal mi Prague wrote further (Gevurot Hashem 60):
“The main praise of a woman and her superior level is
determined through her Tzeniut”**

**The Chazon Ish ZTKL was once asked: “What can a young
lady do that would compare to the merit of a young man's
Torah study? He replied: “Let her work on her Tzniut”**
